Greater Lincoln Christian Academy Statement of Faith

- We believe the Holy Scripture, consisting of the sixty-six books from Genesis to Revelation, to be the verbally and plenary inspired Word of God. It is the final authority for faith, practice and life, inerrant and infallible in the original writing. (II Timothy 3:16-17; II Peter 1:21; Matthew 5:18)
- We believe that the Godhead eternally exists in three persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit; and these three are one God, having precisely the same nature, attributes, and perfection and being worthy of the same homage, confidence and obedience. (Deuteronomy 6:4; John 1:1-4; Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 5:3-4; Hebrews 1:1-3)
 - A. We believe that God the Father is perfect in holiness, infinite in wisdom, and measureless in power. He concerns Himself mercifully with the affairs of men. He hears and answers prayer, and He saves from sin and death all who come to Him through Jesus Christ our Lord.
 - B. We believe that God the Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, became man without ceasing to be God, having been conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary, in order that He might reveal God and redeem sinful men. (John 1:14; Luke 1:35) He accomplished our redemption through His death on the cross as a representative, vicarious sacrifice.
